ABOUT MARATHA VIDYA PRASARAK SAMAJ, NASHIK

The Revolutionary thought of **Mahatma Jyotirao Phule** - "There is no other alternative but education for social change created an awareness about education in the common masses of Maharashtra .The same thought was pursued by the great thinker-reformers like His Highness **Rajarshee Shahu Maharaj**, His Highness **Shreemant Sayajirao Gaikwad Maharaj**, **Maharshee Vitthal Ramji Shinde**, **Dr.Babasaheb Ambedkar**, **Dr.Karmveer Bhaurao Patil**, **Dr.Punjabrao Deshmukh** and many others.These visionaries firmly believed that unless we open the channels of education from pre-primary to higher level, the light of knowledge will not reach to the doors of masses in the villages.The followers of this tradition, **Karmveer Raosaheb Thorat**, **Karmveer Ganpatdada More**, **D.R.Bhosale** and others initiated the task of spreading education by establishing '**Udoji Maratha Hostel**' in Nashik in 1914 .It was a significant beginning of Maratha Vidya Prasarak Samaj.It was in 1914 that All India Maratha Education Conference was organized in Nashik where His Highness **Shreemant Udojirao Pawar Maharaj** of **Dhar Residency** donated Rs.10,000/- which strengthened the very foundation of the Institution. In order to stabilise the work of the Institution, His Highness started a grant of Rs. 2,000 /- per annum. **Rajarshee Shahu Maharaj** donated Rs.150,000 /-, **Shreemant Sayajirao Gaikwad Maharaj** donated Rs.12,000/-, His Highness **Shreemant Madhavrao Maharaj of Gwalior Residency** donated Rs.10,000/- .The then **Industrialist Pandurang Javaji Chaudhari** of Mumbai donated Rs.3,000/- and many others blessed the Institution in the form of donation so as to enable it to expand its educational work.

'**Bahujan Hitaya Bahujan Sukhaya**' 'Education for the Welfare and Happiness of the Common Masses' is the motto of the Institution .To follow this motto and to help the masses, the then social workers like **Shankarrao Kadam**, **Kirtiwantrao Nimbalkar**, **Vitthalrao Gadhave**, **Kanaladkar**, **Bhausahaheb Hiray** ,**Kakasaheb Wagh**, **Annasaheb Murkute** came forward. The Institution (MVP Samaj) gained name and fame in a short time due to well organization and disciplined planning. Since its inception various donars and social workers belonging to various places generously helped the Institution, the small plant of the Institution began to blossom. The year 1964 was celebrated as its Golden Jubilee year. The year 2014 was celebrated as its Centenary.The qualitative and quantitative sky rocketing development of the Institution is simply wonderful.The contribution and devotion of the ex-office bearers and in office bearers as well as the members of the Executive Council have made the miraculous development possible.

The Government of Maharashtra felicitated the Institution by giving a State Award to honour its educational and social work in 2000. **Yashwantrao Chavan Maharashtra Open University ,Nashik** praised the Institution by giving it the '**Punjabrao Deshmukh Award**' in 2006.

ADMISSION TO VARIOUS COURSES

A) Eligibility conditions and rules regarding the admission to the XI and XII std. :

1) **XI std.** : A student who has passed S.S.C. examination conducted by the Maharashtra State Board of Secondary and Higher Secondary Education or equivalent examinations with English as a compulsory subject and students from C.B.S.E. Board can be admitted to XI Class.

2) **XII std.** : A student who has passed XI from the recognized Junior College in Maharashtra or equivalent exam. can be admitted to XII std.

3) The student is responsible to fulfil the eligibility conditions.

Note : Students seeking admission for science faculty should have passed at least with 40% marks in S.S.C examination in the first attempt.

B) Documents Required :

1) Attested copies of statements of marks and passing certificates

2) Original School Leaving Certificate (with Two attested copies)

3) Five passport size coloured photographs

4) Migration Certificate (In case of students from other states)

5) Caste Certificate (with Two attested copies) if applicable

6) Affidavit in case of gap in education and/or change of name.

(Gap should not be of more than one year.)

7) Aadhaar Card/ UIDAI Card

Note: Student will not get back their original documents submitted to the college once they are admitted. They may keep the extra attested copies with them before taking the admission.

E) Examination Pattern

XI- The College will conduct Tests, Language Orals, Practicals, Term End and Annual Exams. The result is based on the average of the total performance of the student for the year.

XII- The Maharashtra State Board of Higher Secondary Education conducts exam. Students will be allowed to appear for the annual examination only if they fulfil the condition of 75% attendance in the class during the academic year.

Note: Unit test I & II, terminal, preliminary examination in the subject Environment Education and the submission of project report is compulsory for the grade in HSC examination.

These courses are conducted by the Central Government. These courses help in reducing the problem of unemployment and motivate self-employment. Considering this, the Government of Maharashtra has started these courses from the year 1988-89. The college runs the following courses.

Special Features of H.S.C. Vocational Courses

1. A student who passes H.S.C. Vocational is eligible to get admission directly to the second year of diploma engineering.
2. A student passing H.S.C. vocational is also eligible to get admission to first year of B.A./B.Com./B.Sc./B.C.A./B.B.A./Hotel management degree course.
3. After completion of the H.S.C. vocational course a student can get an apprenticeship at various industries/organisations like H.A.L., Mahindra, Mico etc.
4. In government, semigovernment or private sector, job opportunity is available for H.S.C. vocational students.
5. A student who passes H.S.C. vocational can get loan facility from government banks to start his business.

ADMISSION TO VARIOUS COURSES

Online Admission will be given to all degree courses

Eligibility conditions and rules regarding the admission to the first year of three-year B.A./B.Com/B.Sc. Degree Course :

A) Admission : Admission to the first year of all courses will be given as per merit at H.S.C. examination, norms and rules of Pune University and Govt. of Maharashtra & Management of the College.

1. The student must have passed H.S.C. examination or any equivalent exam. of authentic and Government recognized body.
2. A student should apply in the prescribed form with necessary certificate of eligibility and fees for admission.
3. Students from other colleges affiliated to the University of Pune will seek admission directly. However, they will have to obtain Transfer Certificate from the previous attended college.
4. A student migrating from other University of Maharashtra and out of Maharashtra should apply in the prescribed form for the 'Eligibility Certificate' with necessary fees.
5. All the fresh admissions will be provisional and will be confirmed after the receipt of Eligibility Certificate from the University of Pune.
6. The First Year students will have to undergo for compulsory medical check up.

B) Documents required :

- 1) Statement of marks and passing certificate
- 2) Leaving Certificate (L.C.) & Transfer Certificate (T.C.)
- 3) Migration Certificate (in case of student from other Universities)
- 4) Caste Certificate
- 5) Character Certificate
- 6) Income Certificate (for availing fee concessions and scholarships)
- 7) Aadhaar card/UIDAI Card



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- 8) Affidavit regarding gap in education and/or change of name.
- 9) Latest three passport size photographs

C) Important Instructions:

- 1) The student seeking admission in this college is liable to pay fees for the whole term.
- 2) The student seeking concession EBC/WPT/STW in fees and/or applying for scholarship should submit the forms along with relevant documents.
- 3) At the time of seeking admission at S.Y. level, the student should have passed F.Y. examination or A.T.K.T. at F.Y. level.
- 4) To get admission in T.Y.B.A./B.Com/B.Sc. the student must have passed in all the subjects of F.Y.B.A./B.Com/B.Sc.

D) Academic year of University of Pune consists of Two Terms.

First Term : from 15 June, 2018

Second Term : After Diwali Vacation

F) Cancellation of admission and Refund of the fees:

The candidate cancelling his confirmed admission will be entitled to the refund of fees after deducting the amount as indicated below except otherwise prescribed by the State Govt. University or competent authorities.

Sanctioned Student Strength : 240 (Grantable) (Two Divisions)

Students seeking admission to F.Y.B.A. shall offer seven subjects as follows:

1. Compulsory English and physical Education are Compulsory Subjects.
2. Those who want to offer 'English' as special at S.Y.B.A. Should offer optional English.
3. The students should offer any five (5) General subjects of the following :
 - i) Hindi or Marathi
 - ii) Economics
 - iii) Geography
 - iv) Political Science
 - v) Optional English or Def. studies
 - vii) History or psychology

B) S.Y.B.A. Course :

Sanctioned student strength : 240 (Granted) (Two Divisions)

Student appearing at S.Y.B.A. will select one subject at special level as well as two more general subjects from the subjects offered at F.Y.B.A. The selection of the subject is as follows:

1. Compulsory English
2. Special Paper No. 1 (S1) - Selected Subject.
3. Special Paper No. 2 (S2) - of the same Subject.



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4. General Paper No. 2 (G2) - of the same subject.
5. Two general subjects other than the special subject.
6. Environment Awareness (Compulsory)
1. Total No. of papers will be seven at S.Y.B.A. level.

NOTE : As per the Savitribai Phule Pune University Circular No. 286 of 2008 a course in "Environment Awareness" is compulsory for S.Y.B.A., S.Y.B.Com and S.Y.B.Sc. Students. Separate examination of this course will be conducted. Students will be given Grades for the course. This Grade will be printed on the statement of marks. Savitribai Phule Pune University will not declare the result of the third year of those students who will either fail or will not appear for the examination.

C) T.Y.B.Sc. (Seats : 120)

The following subjects are taught as special subjects at T.Y.B.Sc. level:

- 1) Physics
 - 2) Chemistry
 - 3) Zoology
 - 4) Mathematics
- The student taking one of these as a special subject must have studied the same at the S.Y.B.Sc. and F.Y.B.Sc. classes.

Note: Subjects once selected will not be changed



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EXAMINATION PATTERN AND MARKS (SENIOR COLLEGE)

- 1) Each paper carries 100 marks.
- 2) 80-20 pattern is adopted for FY/SY/TY BA/B.Com and FY.B.Sc.
- 3) Semester pattern is adopted for S.Y./T.Y.B.Sc./M.A. as prescribed by the University of Pune.
- 4) Examination details and marks distribution will be according to the latest instructions and guidelines given by the University of Pune Examination Section.
- 5) For S.Y.B.Sc. Optional English/Marathi subjects, students will have to appear for Practical Examination (Oral Test of 20 marks)
- 6) Students offering NCC and NSS and students awarded at state level debating, drama and sports competitions are liable to claim 5 marks at the end of their final year under ordinance 163 of Pune University. It is applicable to all faculties.
- 7) At S.Y.B.A./B.Com/B.Sc. students will have to appear for the compulsory Course in 'Environmental Awareness'.
- 8) At FYBA/B.Com/B.Sc. students will have to appear for the compulsory course in Physical Education.

The college also runs as a study center for the various courses conducted by YCMOU. Yashwantrao Chavan Maharashtra Open University (YCMOU) was established in Nashik by the Maharashtra Legislative Assembly Act. No. 20/1989 on July First 1989. The University is recognized by the UGC under section 12B. YCMOU jurisdiction, once limited to the State of Maharashtra at the inception, is extended in 2003 to suit global operations as per amendments in the Act by the Maharashtra Legislative Assembly, it is the fifth open university in the country.

Motto :- ज्ञानमोक्षाय सर्वेषु - Translated literally, the motto suggests "the river of knowledge at every home". The motto reflects the aim, to transmit the flow of knowledge to the home of the common man.



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General Programmes at the Study Centre

1) Preparatory course : There is a complete open entry to this programme once a person has completed 18 years of age. No minimum educational level or any other qualification is required for registration. It is a short two months duration course conducted in July-August February- March of every academic year.

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competitions are eligible to claim 5 marks at the end of their final year under 163 ordinance of the University of Pune. It is applicable to all faculties.

IQAC : The Internal Quality Assurance Cell is after quality in everything that happens on the college campus.

Students' Grievance Redressal Committee : The committee looks into the grievances and problems of students. The students can approach the committee for their academic, administrative and personal problems in the college either personally or through the complaint boxes.

The Anti-Ragging Committee : The Anti Ragging Committee has been established in the college. The Committee looks forward to sort out the problems of those students who are victimized by ragging. The students

Student Council : The students council will be formed as per the Rules and regulations of S.P.P. University, Pune and The Govt. of Maharashtra

Earn and Learn Scheme : The scheme has been actively implemented for the poor and needy students, who would like to work for a few hours on the college campus to get some financial help.

SCHOLARSHIPS AND CONCESSIONS AT SENIOR & JUNIOR COLLEGE

Various Scholarships offered and Eligibilities for them :

1. National Merit Scholarship :
- Minimum 50% marks in Annual Examination available up to graduation.
2. Open Merit State Government scholarship : As per Merit I
3. Primary and Secondary Teacher's wards Merit Scholarship : As per merit.
4. Hindi Scholarship : For students having mother tongue other than Hindi and have passed in Hindi as a subject in the previous year examination.
5. Scholarship for Physically Handicapped : Certificate of Handicap issued by the civil surgeon.
6. Merit Scholarship in Mathematics and Physics.
7. Scholarship on Merit and Income : Merit + Income of parents
8. Central Government Scholarship for SC/ST/NT students: Students belonging to Government notified: SC/ST/NT categories like Mahar, Mang, Chambhar, Dhor, Bhil, Mahadev Koli, Gond, Phase Pardhi etc.
9. Rajashri Chhatrapati Shahu Maharaj Scholarship : SC, NT and SBC students securing 75% marks or more are eligible for this scholarship.
10. Other Backward Class (OBC) scholarship : OBC students having OBC caste certificate from competent authority and income of parents less than Rs. 1,00,000/- are eligible for this scholarship.
12. Other Backward Class (OBC) Freeship : All OBC students having OBC caste certificate from competent authority are eligible



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for this freeship.

13. **Minority Scholarship Scheme** (Post-Matric Scholarship) as per Government of Maharashtra GR (542/07) the Scholarship is applicable for minority communities such as Muslim, Parsi, Shikh, Christian, Buddhist and Jain students. The students who are economically backward from these communities are entitled to get free education from 11th Std to Ph. D. provided they have obtained 50% of marks in the examination attended previously.

14. **Savitribai Phule Financial Assistance Scheme** : The financially poor girl students of the college can avail Savitribai Phule Financial Assistance Scheme run by the S.P. Pune University.

If a student getting scholarship fails in the examination, she/he is not eligible for the scholarship twice (while studying in the same class). Students eligible for the scholarship should collect application forms from the college office at the time of admission. The duly completed scholarship forms, accompanied with necessary authentic documents must be submitted on line and in the office before given due date and the receipt of the same obtained from the college office should be maintained. No complaints, inquiries regarding the scholarship and fee concession will be entertained after 31st March. For any difficulty contact the appropriate college authority.

Fee Concessions:

1) Concession in fees for the freedom fighters' wards :

Applications are to be sent to the Zilha Parishad office.

2) E.B.C. concession : This concession is given to students whose parents' income is less than Rs. One lac in previous year. The prescribed forms are available in the college office.

Students desirous to apply for this concession should collect forms from the college office and should submit it before 15th July. Following documents must be attached along with the EBC concession form:

A) **Income certificate for the students from :**

i) Rural areas : Income certificate should have been attested by the member of Zilha Parishad or Panchayat Samiti.

ii) Urban areas (population more than 10,000) 'The income certificate must be Attested by either Executive Magistrate or Tahasildar or Corporator of the Municipal Corporation.

B) **Affidavit of the parent (for rural areas)**

3. Concession in fees for Secondary Teachers Wards/Primary Teachers Wards:

This fee concession is given to the students whose parents are secondary teachers/Primary teachers (with SSC, D. Ed or STC). Application in prescribed proforma should be submitted to the college before 15th July.



4. Concession in tuition fees as per the directions given by the MVP Samaj for its employees' children.
5. Students who fulfil necessary criteria, (both educational and economic) are given concessions in fees. It is the responsibility of the students to fill in the necessary forms within due dates, to secure acknowledgement and to preserve it for the academic year.

GENERAL RULES OF DISCIPLINE

Students will follow all the norms of discipline of the college. Rules regarding routine work, behaviour on the campus, classrooms and library, at various functions and during examinations should be properly observed by all the students.

The regulations jointly made by the University of Pune, Educational Council, State Government and College Management should be strictly followed by all students.

- 1) Uniform code is compulsory for all the students.
- 2) Students must carry their Identity Cards with them on the college campus.
- 3) Vehicles must be parked at the parking places only.
- 4) Students must not bunk lectures/practicals.
- 5) Smoking, drinking, liquor, chewing gutkha, pan masala and spitting is strictly prohibited on the college campus.
- 6) Photography on the campus is not allowed.
- 7) Weapons that may cause physical injury are prohibited on the campus.
- 8) Writing anything on the walls of classroom or toilet, throwing pieces of paper, materials and scraps any where on the campus is prohibited.
- 9) The furniture , lamps, fans etc. in the classroom should be used carefully. No damage should in any way be caused to the college property.
- 10) Shouting, causing nuisance, banging on staircase, speaking in the reading hall, loitering in the college porch are prohibited.
- 11) Visitors are not allowed in the campus unless special permission is granted.
- 12) Students will have to follow all the rules made by the laboratories and the library.
- 13) Students are not allowed to enter on the terrace or in the garden without permission.
- 14) Study tours could be arranged only by the permission of the Principal. The college will not be responsible for the tours conducted without permission.



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- 15) In case of any complaint, contact the Principal. Do not directly-approach the newspapers or any other media.
- 16) No student will participate in any anti-social or anti-college campaign. Nor will they take part in any religious movement.
- 17) Students will participate in all constructive activities and co-operate in all extra curricular, curricular and cultural activities organized by the college.
- 18) Use of unfair means in the examination is a punishable offence.
- 19) Original Certificates once submitted will not be returned.
- 20) Strict action will be taken if any alterations in documents are made.
- 21) No groups , organizations, forums of students are formed in the campus without prior permission of the Authorities.
- 22) The examination forms will be detained if students would have less than 75% attendance.
- 23) Students will have to observe all other regulations made from time to time by college authorities.
- 24) Students progress will be informed to the parents periodically.
- 25) Ragging in any form is strictly prohibited. Ragging is an offence.
- 26) The students must keep their mobiles on silent mode when they are on the campus.

The Following measures maybe taken in case of non-observance of rules and regulations

- 1) Cancellation of admission
- 2) Cancellation of examination forms
- 3) Stopping Scholarship
- 4) Rustication from examination/college
- 5) Withholding examination results
- 6) Suspension from college
- 7) Penalization for indisciplinary act on the college campus
- 8) Confiscation of deposit
- 9) Lodging a complaint in the Police Station.
- 10) Reporting to the Appropriate Authorities.



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**Circular No. 170 of 2009
UNIVERSITY OF PUNE**

It is hereby notified for information of all concerned that in view of the Judgement and Order dated 11.2.2009 of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in the matter of the University of Kerala V/s Council of Principals of Colleges in Kerala and Others, the following measures shall be taken to prevent ragging in the colleges/Institutions :

1. In the prospectus of the Higher Educational Institutions, it should be mentioned that if any incident of ragging comes to the notice of the authority concerned, the accused student will be given an opportunity to explain and if his explanation is not satisfactory, the authority would expel him from the institution. The number of cases of ragging and punishment given by the educational institutions in the previous academic year should also be incorporated in the prospectus of Higher Educational Institutions.
 2. Anti ragging committees and squads to check ragging should be constituted and the names and telephone numbers of officials to be contacted by the students in case of ragging, should also be published.
 3. Counseling sessions and orientation courses for senior and fresh students should be conducted.
 4. All institutions should do whatever they can by ensuring punishment to the students found guilty of ragging, giving wide publicity to such punishments to act as a deterrent, strict enforcement of the various measures for preventing ragging.
 5. Appropriate messages regarding "zero tolerance" towards ragging should be incorporated in admission notices/ advertisements.
 6. Audio-video campaign should be undertaken at the commencement of the new academic session to prevent ragging.
 7. Efforts to publicize and sensitize students regarding the menace of ragging should be made.
 8. Awareness amongst students through student unions about the bad effects of ragging should be generated.
 9. In appropriate cases, if the authorities are prima facie satisfied about the errant act of any student, they can suspend the student from the institution and the hostel, if any, pending final decision and give opportunity to him to have his say. The Police should be informed immediately and criminal law should be set into motion.
- It is further notified that the Colleges/Institutions shall submit report to the Director, Students' Welfare of the University, every six months, regarding implementation of the measures taken by them to prevent ragging.
